



Are you thinking, how I could help CASA? Plan on spending a couple hours shooting and having fun, and now you have an *extra five minutes?*

Try out one of the below quickie projects: Just one five-minute project makes a big difference.

Remember, we do not have paid help here at CASA, it is all volunteer.

### Five Minutes Projects – Every one done is great

1. Refill the clubhouse refrigerator with soda and bottle water. The extra cans and bottles are next to the refrigerator, just fill it up, that is it, easy and simple.

2. Clean the bathroom. We all know it is our least favorite job, but just think if it is never done? We are not asking for you to clean it enough to eat off the titlet, but a little cleaning does wonders. Empty the trash can, make sure the TP and Paper Towels are there, spray down the titlets and sink and wipe them down.

3. Empty the trash cans, wipe down the microwave counter, make sure the Paper Towels and TP are filled. Spare rolls are {Location of TP/PT}

4. Sweep out the club-house and wipe down the table, pick up any trash.

5. Sweep or blow out the leaves and dirt from the pavilion.

6. Empty the trash cans in the pavilion, you can drop the trash bags as you exit CASA, the big green trash can is right by the paved road. Empty bags are inside the club-house by the back door.

7. Pull up weeds and water the bushes (Spring/Summer) at the Armed Forces Memorial.

8. Clean up the bay you were shooting at, stack the target stands, throw out broken sticks, empty the trash can and put in a fresh bag. (Hint: make life easy for you, put a few extra bags in the bottom of the can).

9. If cleaning up your bay only takes a minute or two, do the bay to the left and/or right of you. Again, take the trash bags to the green can out by the road.

10. If you see something missing, damage or not just right and do not know what to do, call or email the BOD. If you see a safety item, take action, just do not leave it for the next person, they may not see it, until it is too late.
