This offer is good only for our regular club matches. - It is a \$15 value!

Required equipment: (if you do not have enough equipment call me before the match and we will figure something out. We want you to shoot with us.)

- 9mm/.38 Special handgun or larger in safe working condition. Auto or revolver.
- 3 magazines minimum, preferably 4 (speed loaders for a revolver).
- 2 magazine/speed loader carriers that ride on the belt.
- Belt holster for the gun you are bringing.
- Usually 130+ rounds of ammo, if possible, bring 200+.
- Protective eye and ear wear is a must.
- Comfortable clothing so you can move easily.

Competition-only equipment is NOT required! There are several divisions in which you can shoot, and your carry gun WILL fit in one of those divisions!

Dubbed as "*The Ultimate Display of Speed and Accuracy*", the speed on steel format has proven to be the single most exciting shooting sport in almost two decades. It is not only extremely popular among shooters, but has proven to be the most media and spectator friendly of all Professional Competitions as well. Recent coverage of the Steel Challenge on The Outdoor Channel, clearly illustrated the point.

The return of the Steel Challenge has created a resurgence of steel shooting, as well as the production of targets, steel guns and associated equipment. However, holding to the same unique format as the Steel Challenge, we will be promoting the varied categories that are friendly to all gun and action types. These Categories include: "**Open Class, Limited** (USPSA guidelines), **Top Revolver**, **Top Lady**, **Stock** Guns and Holsters of **IDPA Custom, IDPA Stock, IDPA Enhanced, Iron Sight Revolver**, and **Law Enforcement, Single Action, Pre-Teen** (10-12), **Junior** (13-17), **Senior** (55-64) and **Super Senior** (65+)" Categories.

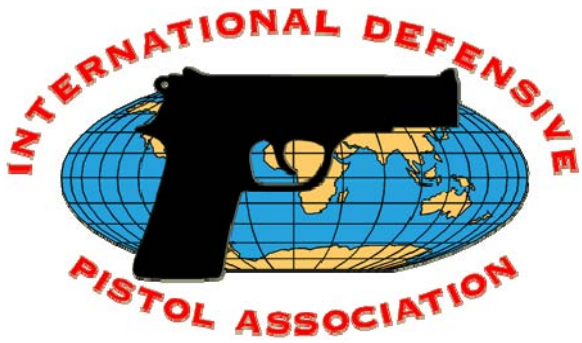
PLUS, we will be promoting two new **Rimfire** categories, one with optics and one without optics. Rimfire will be fired from the "I.S.I. ready position", which is described as both elbows touching the competitor's side with the muzzle pointing downrange and the finger off the trigger.

Sign in is at 9:30 am and shooting starts at 10:00 AM the third Saturday of the month. However, you should always check the website for verification. www.casorange.com Then go to the CALENDAR.

Required equipment: (if you do not have enough equipment call me before the match and we will figure something out. We want you to shoot with us.)

- 9mm/.38 Special handgun or larger in safe working condition. Auto or Revolver.
- 3 magazines minimum (speed loaders for a revolver).
- 2 magazine/speed loader carriers that ride on the belt.
- Belt holster for the gun you are bringing.
- Usually 80+ rounds of ammo, but if possible bring 150.
- Protective eye and ear wear is a must.
- Comfortable clothing so you can move easily including a cover garment which is a shirt or jacket.

There are several divisions in which you can shoot, and your carry gun WILL fit in one of those divisions!

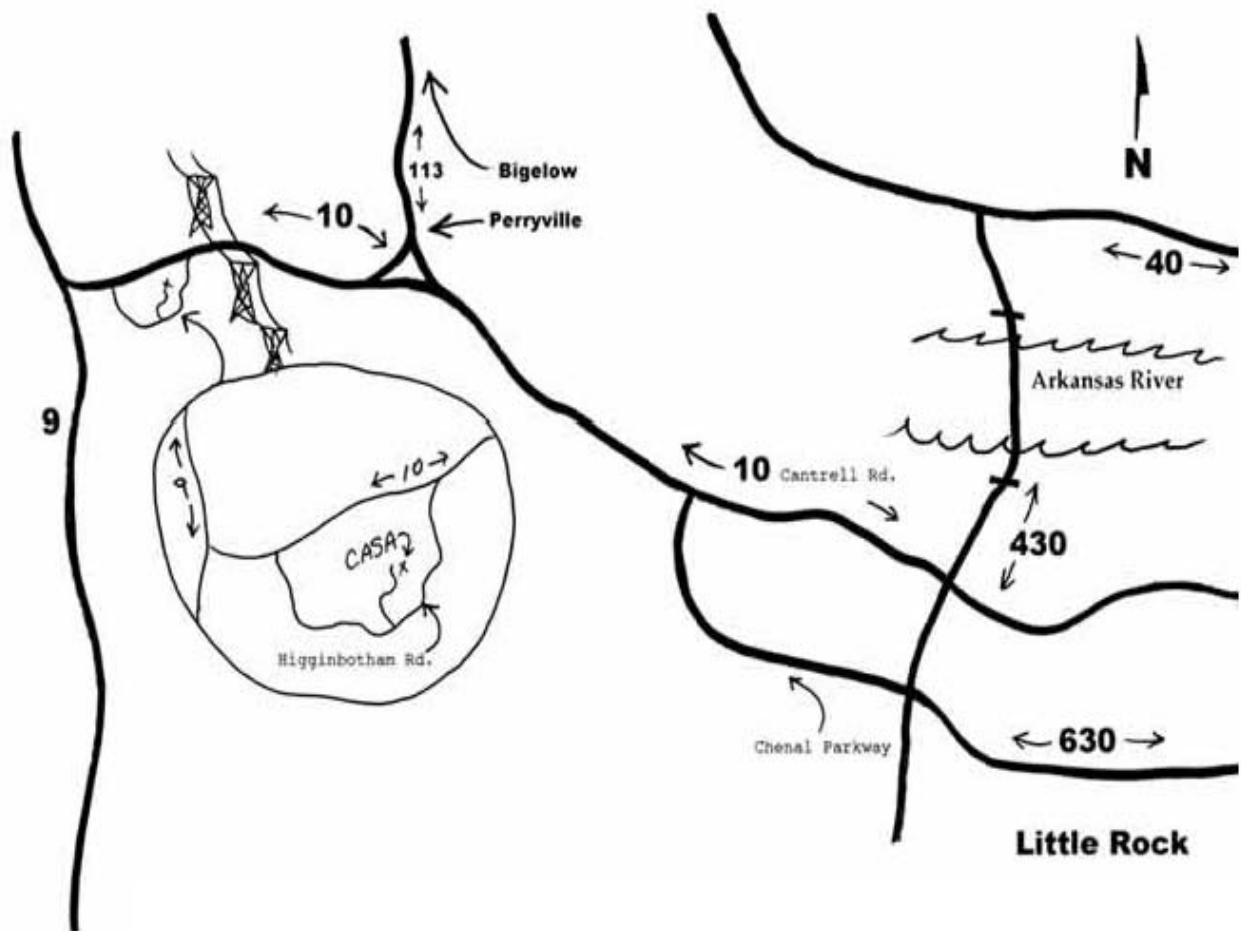
CASA has 14 pistol ranges with nine 12' x 12' sheds to keep the sun or rain off of you. A rifle range with 50, 100 and 200 yard berms. A clubhouse with restrooms. A 40' x 60' pavilion for meetings or just cooling off in the summer time.

CASA has hosted 4 National IDPA events; 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006 Nationals. CASA has also hosted a numerous shooting events not quite as large as the Nationals, but no less fun and challenging.

All members receive a key to all of the facilities. CASA members are on the honor system. Guests are permitted when accompanied by a member.

CASA offers 4 different shooting sports: USPSA, IDPA and Steel Challenge and Multi-Gun occasionally. Join our fine club or just come and shoot with us, we would love to have you.

We are located just outside of Little Rock on Highway 10 just before you get to Perryville.

CASA is located 21.5 miles outside of Little Rock on Hwy.10 (Cantrell Rd.) from I-430. Take Hwy 10 west past Lake Maumelle, (from Bigelow – Perryville sign travel 4.1 miles towards Perryville) to Higginbotham Rd. Turn left past the POWER LINES onto Higginbotham Rd. Go 1.1 miles to CASA’s driveway, turn right, go up the drive ¼ mile and the Club House is on your right.
